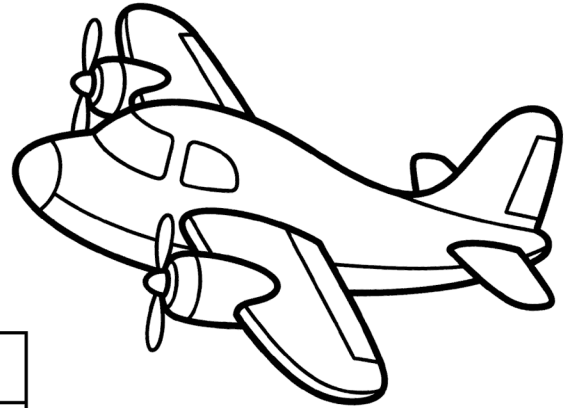
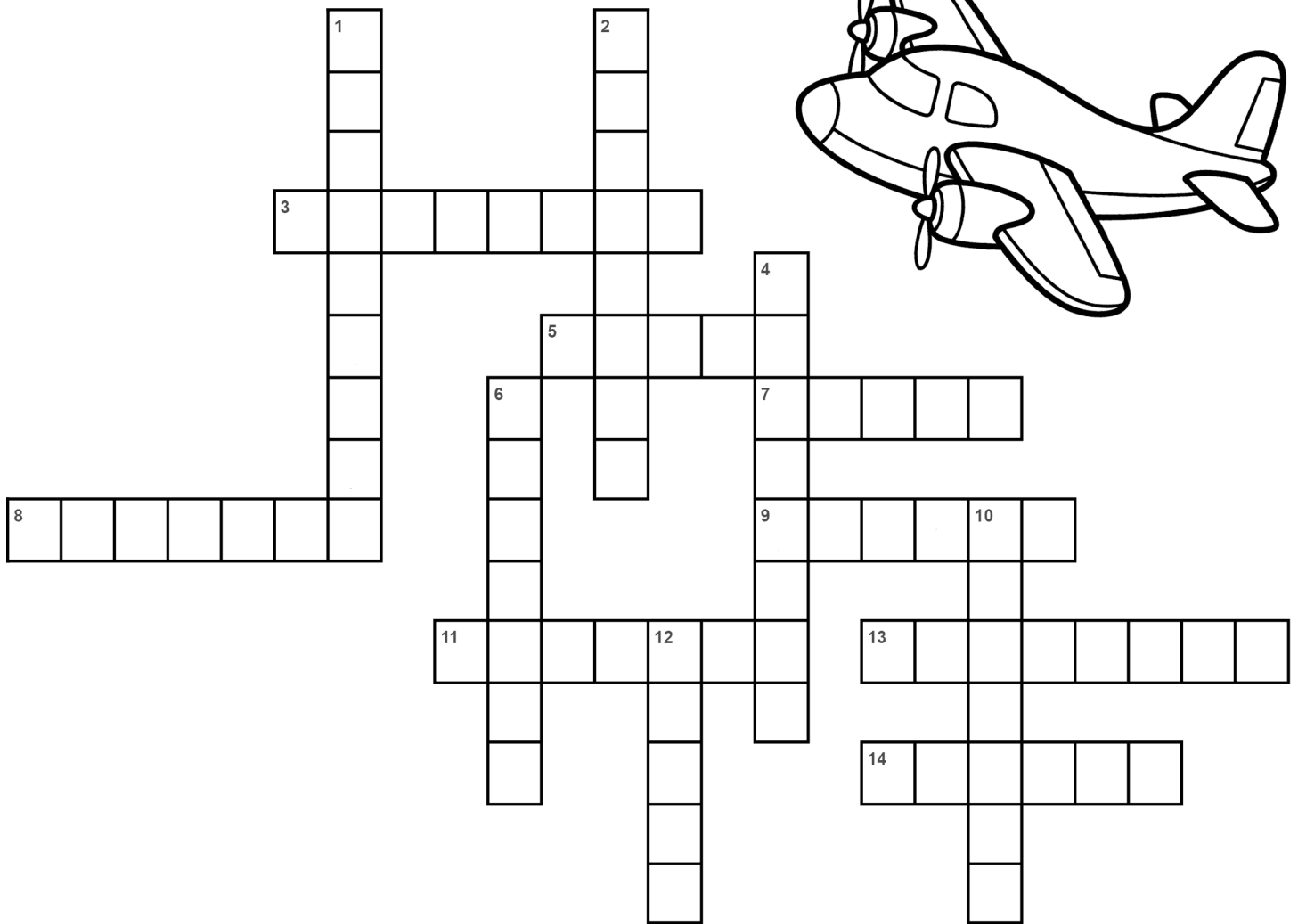


Airplane travel
