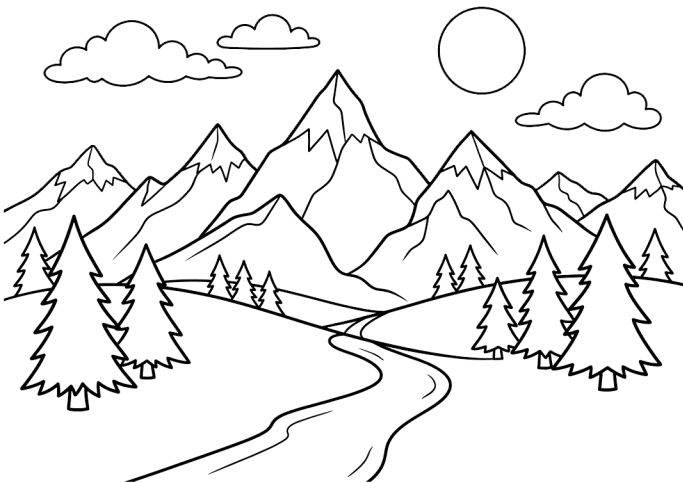
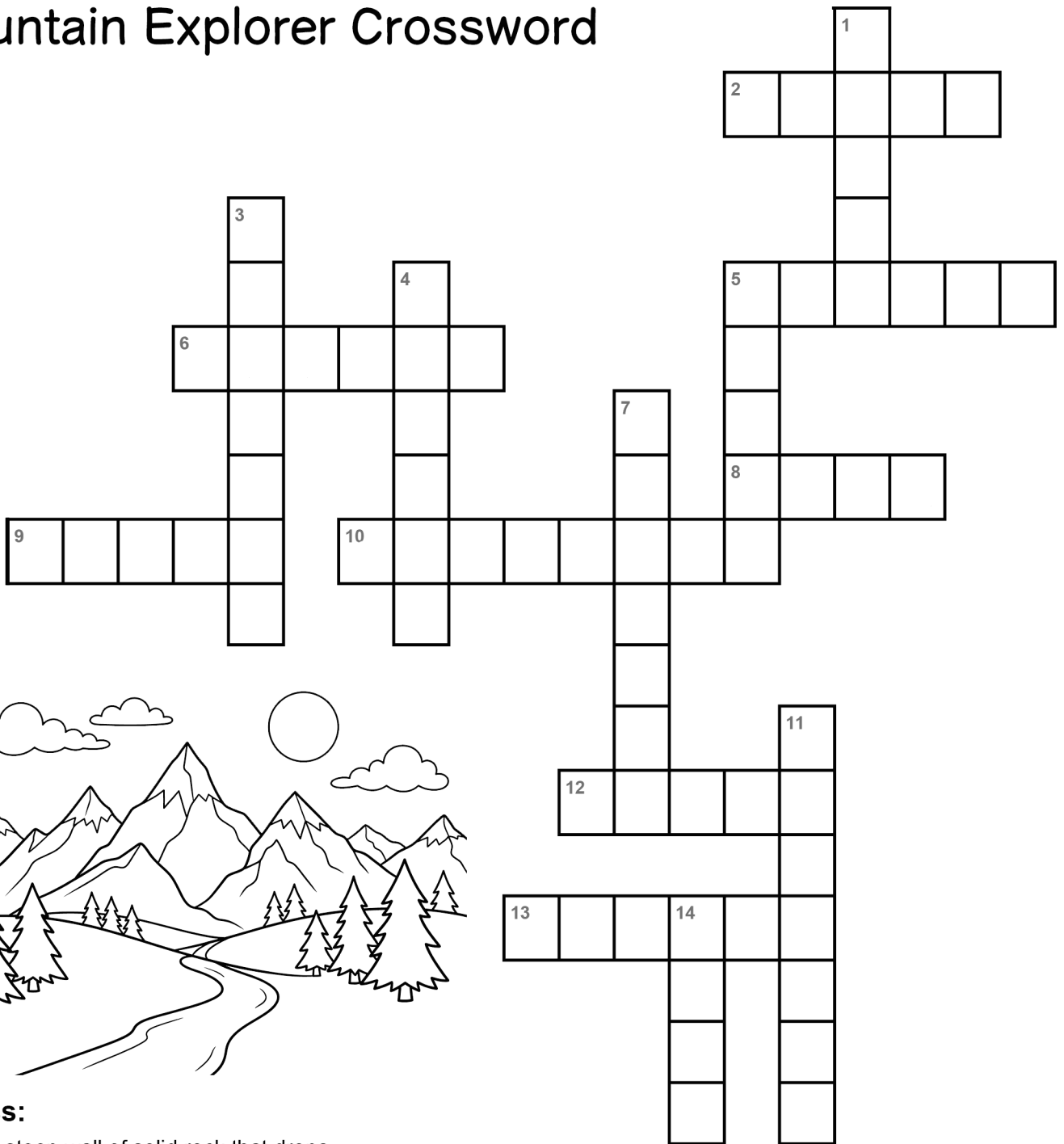


Mountain Explorer Crossword
