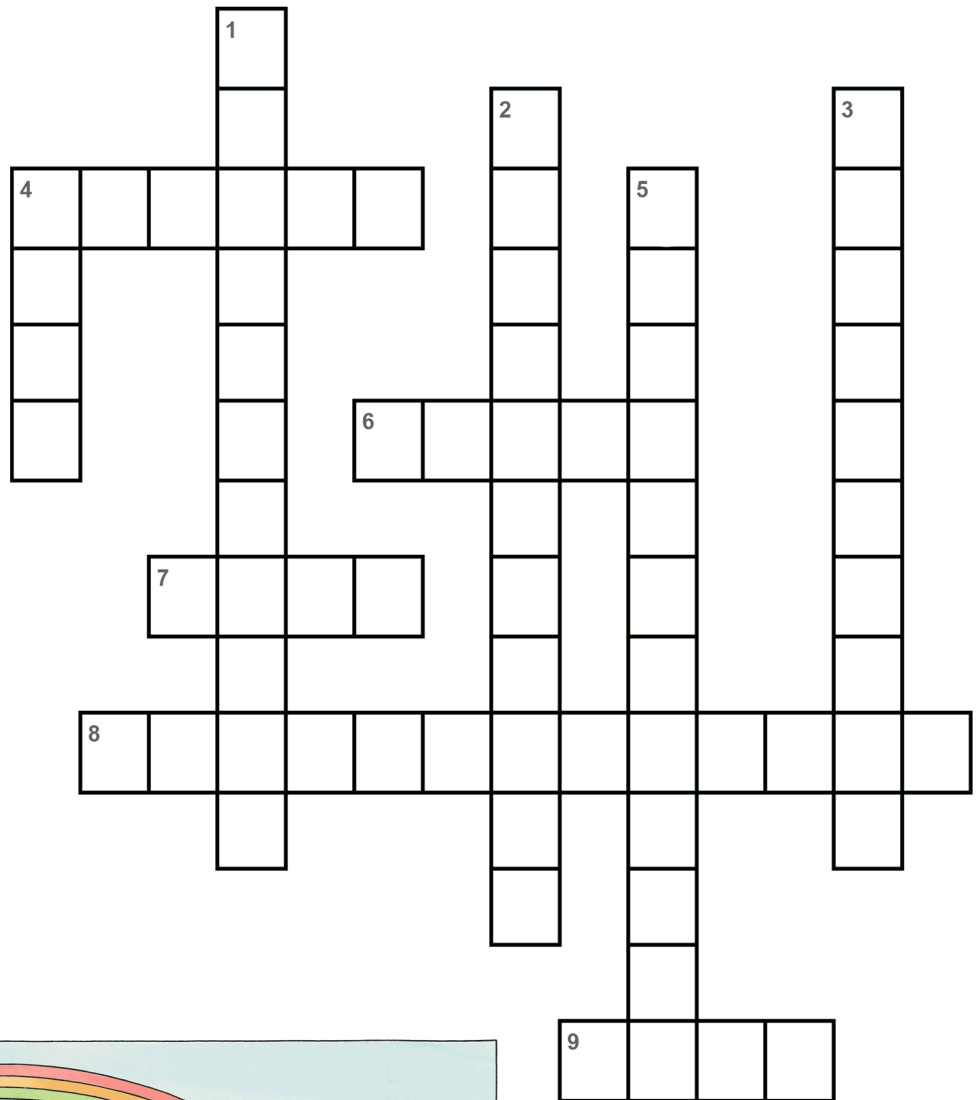
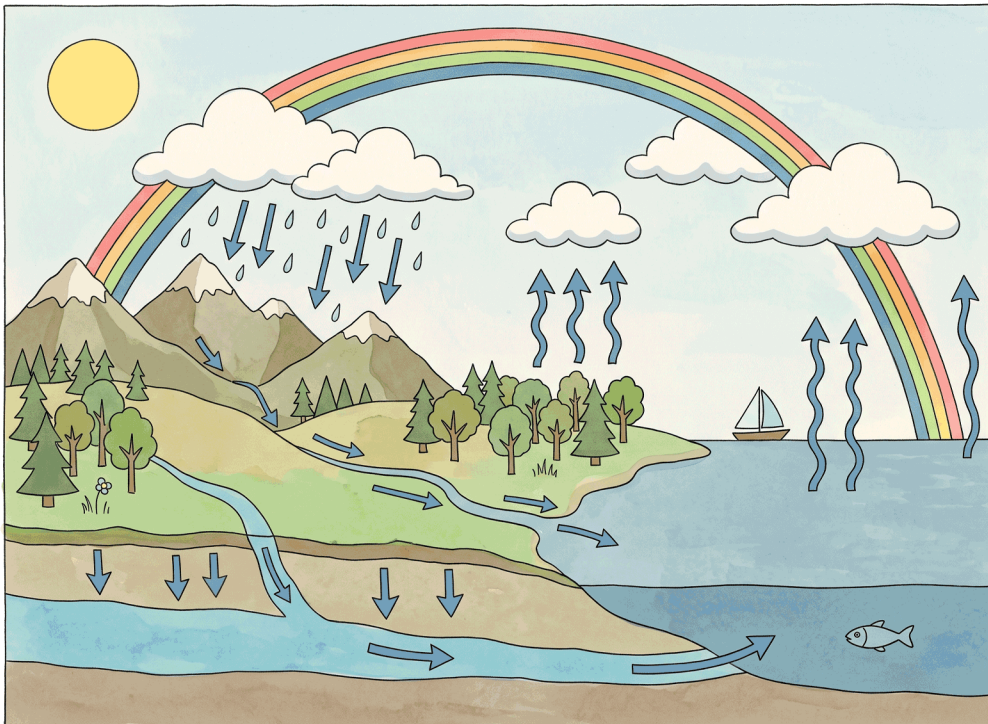


The Water Cycle Crossword



Down:

1. The water that hides under our feet, beneath Earth's surface.
2. When the sun heats up puddles and turns the liquid into invisible gas.
3. When water gathers in oceans, lakes, and rivers after falling from the sky.
4. Normal liquid drops of water that fall from the sky to help plants grow.
5. When warm gas cools down high in the air and turns back into tiny liquid drops.



Across:

4. Liquid that flows across the top of the land and down hills into streams or lakes instead of soaking into the soil.
6. A fluffy white or gray shape floating high up, made of billions of tiny water drops.
7. Hard balls of ice that drop from the sky during big storms.
8. The big science term for any water falling from the sky to the Earth.
9. Cold, soft white flakes made of ice crystals that fall in the winter.
